'Ride for Free Scheme'

Applicant

An applicant is a rider who will directly benefit from the free entry (s) which may be accrued by volunteering in person at Cumbria Horse Trials events or by nominating a family member. Each rider will need to complete a **Volunteer Log Book** and a **Volunteer Event Form**. By providing some personal details below a rider confirms they would like to be part of the 'Ride for Free Scheme'.

Volunteer Log Book

The purpose of the Log Book is simply to record the number of hours volunteered and to therefore maintain a record of a rider's entitlement to Free Entry at a variety of Cumbria Horse Trials competitions. The Log Book will record the number of hours volunteered, the role, any feedback and the allocation of Free Entry(s) entitlement. The Log Book will include details of 'how to enter on-line' using the www.cumbriahorsetrials.com website. It is a rider's responsibility to ensure that they bring their Log Book with them on the day(s) attended and have it signed by Douglas or Lucinda Weymouth at the end of their volunteering period.

2017 Volunteer Event Form

This form indicates the dates and roles available for volunteering across the 2017 Cumbria Horse Trials events. This form also indicates how much time is usually needed per role or whether the role can be undertaken as a half or full day commitment. The form should be returned by email preferably NO LATER than 10 days before any chosen event date or if a rider can commit to multiple dates then submitting the form prior to the start of the season is similarly very helpful. Lucinda will make contact to confirm the timings and roles at the latest early in the week of each event. Ideally, we ask all volunteers to stay committed to any dates they have kindly offered to volunteer on.

We always ensure that new volunteers are buddied up with an experienced volunteer and we provide refreshments throughout the day. In early 2017 the **Volunteer Log Books** will be posted out to all Applicants and by February applicants will receive via email the **2017 Volunteer Form**.
